Wall of Honor DEDICATED TO FOUNDATION'S DONORS

Over 70 guests attended the Foundation's Wall of Honor Dedication on September 23, 2021 held at the Petersen Foyer of Kewanee High School. "Tonight's dedication is a wonderful opportunity to celebrate and express our gratitude to you, our donors, for your role in the success of the Kewanee Schools Foundation and Kewanee School District," stated Lori Christiansen, President of the Kewanee Schools Foundation, and Vice-President of the Kewanee Community Unit School District #229 Board of Education. "I would like to officially dedicate the Wall of Honor to all of our donors, for your continued generous and kind support."

The Foundation was in need of remodeling its Wall of Honor which was originally installed in 2001. The increase in the number of donors and donations since that time required the Foundation to re-categorize and add new levels to the Wall, to allow for growth, both now and in the future. Peoples National Bank sponsored the original Wall of Honor, as well as the upgraded system now on display. In addition, Joan's Trophy donated four additional plaques displayed to the left of the main system, which includes a new Legacy Society plaque. The Wall of Honor represents cumulative donations (including in-kind gifts) through June 30, 2021 and will be updated annually.

A highlight of the evening, the Foundation took the

opportunity to induct eleven inaugural members into its newly established Legacy Society. "By joining the KSF Legacy Society, you are leaving a legacy of your values and dreams to the children of Kewanee Community Unit School District #229 by naming Kewanee Schools Foundation as beneficiary of your will, Trust, retirement plan, life insurance policy or other planned giving vehicle" said Ms. Christiansen. "You have joined a special group of donors who have made the decision to make a significant positive impact to secure the future of Kewanee Community Unit School District #229", she added.

Dr. Christopher Sullens, Superintendent, shared his appreciation to the Foundation's donors, and gave a brief history of the expansion within the District since the Foundation's inception. The evening concluded with an optional tour of the recent additions to Kewanee High School including the new biology lab and classroom featuring the state-of-the-art digital anatomy table; art classroom/lab; Group Interpretation/Pom-Pon room, and home economics lab complete with a new commercial kitchen to assist students with an interest in pursuing a career in the restaurant/food industry.

Since its founding in 1990, Kewanee Schools Foundation has supported and nurtured children and educators as part of its mission to strengthen the educational opportunities for students of the Kewanee School District and promote community engagement within the District. This work remains critical today and well into the future.

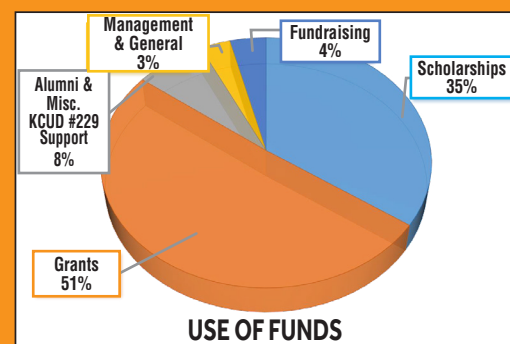
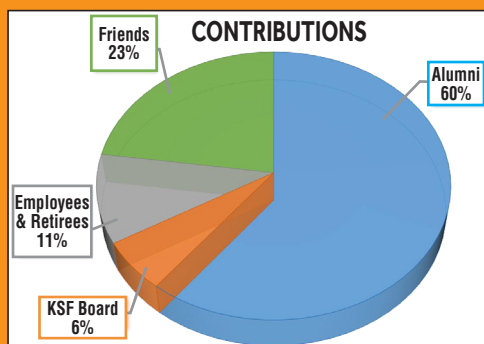

Digital Anatomy Table Added to Kewanee High School Science Classroom



The Kewanee School District is the proud owner of a fully segmented real human 3D anatomy system that allows students to visualize anatomy exactly how it would look on a fresh cadaver. This cutting-edge piece of technology allows students to rotate the human body 360 degrees, take it apart, identify specific structures and look at multiple views at the same time.

The Anatomage Table was added to the Kewanee High School science lab and purchased by the Kewanee Schools Foundation through the Dr. Frances Horler Trust. Dr. Horler was a 1927 graduate of KHS, who left a \$2.1 million bequest from her estate to the Foundation to be used for academic excellence.

The table is seven feet long and can be displayed horizontally or vertically. The touch screen feature makes it interactive, and has multiple classroom applications. The table is used for introductory lessons, lectures and assessments. Students are also able to use the equipment to perform activities such as test and laboratory practicals.

The KHS table is one of only seven tables being used in high school classrooms across the state.



Robert L. Petersen Excellence in Education Grants Awarded

A total of \$2,180 in grants was awarded in 2021 to fund English Language Arts (ELA) and Science materials and curriculum to enhance remote learning instruction in Grades 6-8; and resources and supplies to implement STEM activities to promote critical thinking for Grade K. To date, over \$17,000 has been awarded from the Robert L. Petersen Excellence in Education grant program.



Harry J. Anderson Memorial Trust Grants Awarded

Nearly \$134,000 has been donated since 2015 to the Kewanee Schools Foundation by the Harry J. Anderson Memorial Trust to create and support programs for the children in the Kewanee School District who need training and guidance in order to get a good start in life and become useful and desirable citizens. The 2021 Harry Anderson Memorial Trust grants funded over \$20,000 for a PearDeck program for the district; Vehicle Career Day for grades K-1; Incentives for the Alternative Program for grades 4-12; Live School program for Self Contained Special Education for grades

7-12; PLATO program for Grades 9-12; SEL curriculum for Grades 4-12; PBIS supplies for Grades 4-8; Business Essentials and Personal Finance course curriculums for Grades 9-12; Introduction to Business and Marketing supplemental activities and projects for Grades 9-12; as well as funding for Dual Credit Scholarships and Junior Achievement.

KHS Students Receive Over \$108,800 in Scholarships

The Kewanee Schools Foundation and the Kewanee School District awarded \$108,854 to the Class of 2021 this year. Awards and scholarships were presented to Kewanee High School seniors at the Senior Assembly and Commencement ceremonies. The assembly and commencement were held outdoors at the high school stadium in May. These scholarships have been made possible through the tremendous generosity of many loyal donors to the Foundation and Kewanee School District.

Local Banks Support Education

The Kewanee Schools Foundation received generous donations from local financial institutions through a partnership with Federal Home Loan Bank of Chicago and Targeted Impact Fund for relief efforts for populations hit hard by COVID-19. A grant of \$5,250 from Union Federal Savings and Loan funded additional mobile Wi-Fi hotspots to assist students in their remote learning; and \$5,000 from State Bank of Toulon benefited the snack program administered by K.C.U.S.D #229. In addition, a grant of \$2,500 was received from Community State Bank, together with mortgage partner Federal Home Loan Bank of Chicago, for a reading program initiative for fifth grade students at Central School.

Why I Support *Kewanee Schools Foundation*

Returning to Kewanee he joined a local manufacturer and took college classes ultimately attaining Associate Degrees in Engineering Technology and Business Management. He quickly advanced in his work as an Engineer, to Supervisor and to Director of Human Resources until his retirement in 2006.
