Trips for 30 years

Kewanee Schools Foundation raised \$61,679 in net proceeds at the "All Aboard for Education! 30 Trips for 30 Years" event held on Saturday, April 23, 2022 at Midland Golf Club to benefit its Dual Credit Scholarship program and Unrestricted Fund (supports the areas of greatest need). Celebrating the Foundation's 30th Anniversary, guests had the opportunity to bid on 30 exciting trips to local and regional destinations, as well as longer trips to national destinations and abroad while supporting a great cause. Thanks to the community's support, the Foundation more than doubled its goal of raising \$30,000.

The Dual Credit Scholarship program gives Kewanee High School students the opportunity to receive high school and college credit simultaneously for certain coursework. As such, many students are able to enter college as sophomores after graduating from KHS, and are spared a year of college expenses.

The evening included a social hour and dinner with International desserts, and featured live musical entertainment provided by Todd Kelly Three. The 30th Anniversary Program included a video tribute to the progress made by the Foundation over the last 30 plus years. First and Business Class Sponsors were presented with special recognition plagues and the Coach Class Sponsors received certificates of appreciation during the program. The Silent and Live Auctions were a big success. 

KHS Students Receive Over \$118,000 in Scholarships

The Kewanee Schools Foundation and the Kewanee School District awarded over \$118,000 to the Class of 2022 this year. Awards and scholarships were presented to Kewanee High School seniors at the Senior Assembly and Commencement ceremonies. The assembly and commencement were held in the Petersen Auditorium and HF Brockman Gym at

Kewanee High School in May. These scholarships have been made possible through the tremendous generosity of many loyal donors to the Foundation and Kewanee School District.

Robert L. Petersen Excellence in Education Grants Awarded

A total of \$550 in grants was awarded in 2022 to a Crime Scene Unit for Grade 7; and reading books for KHS Spanish classrooms. To date, over \$17,500 has been awarded from the Robert L. Petersen Excellence in Education grant program.

Harry J. Anderson Memorial Trust Grants Awarded

Nearly \$155,000 has been donated since 2015 to the Kewanee Schools Foundation by the Harry J. Anderson Memorial Trust to create and support programs for the children in the Kewanee School District

who need training and guidance in order to get a good start in life and become useful and desirable citizens. The 2022 Harry Anderson Memorial Trust grants funded over \$20,729 for a vacuum forming machine for the District #229; Incentives for the Alternative Program for grades 4-12; Science curriculum for Grade 3 and 4; SEL curriculum for Grades 4-12; PBIS supplies for Grades 4-8: Business Essentials and Personal Finance course curriculums for Grades 9-12; Introduction to Business and Marketing supplemental activities and projects for Grades 9-12; as well as funding for Dual Credit Scholarships and Junior Achievement.
