2023 Notes to Scholarship Candidates

The Kewanee Music Boosters, in an effort to encourage students to engage in a continued pursuit of excellence and a lifelong love of music, are offering one scholarship to a graduating senior who exemplifies these qualities. For 2023, the scholarship has been set at \$500.

Conditions:

- All applicants must have completed at least **two** years (four credits) in band and/or choir class(es) at Kewanee High School.
- The scholarship recipient will be announced at graduation.
- Prior to issuance of the scholarship money, the recipient must provide the Kewanee Schools Foundation with proof of enrollment at the college or university listed on the scholarship application. Should the recipient elect to attend a different college or university than the one listed on the application, the Kewanee Music Boosters Scholarship Committee shall review the information after the recipient has submitted a revised application. The committee will either approve the scholarship for the new college or university, award the scholarship to another applicant, or transfer the scholarship funds to the following school year.

 - Why is music important to you?
 - What inspired you to continue with music throughout high school and into college?
